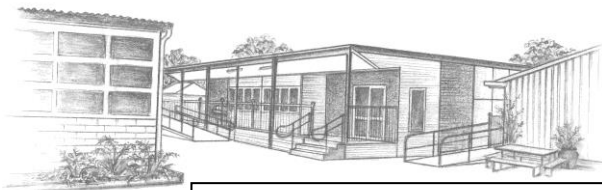

### MINI NEWSLETTER

- 1. Curriculum Day** - A reminder that no students are required at school tomorrow - families need to make alternative arrangements. All staff will be at Shepparton at a Professional Development on the BIG WRITE program. This is our 2nd Curriculum Day for the year. School will resume on Wednesday as per normal - photo day.
- 2. School Photos** - Envelopes are due now for the Photo Day on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> April. Family envelopes can be collected from the office if needed.
- 3. Life Ed. Van** - This program will be at our school on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> April. A reminder that Permission Forms are due along with a payment of \$4 per student. Again, special thanks to the Tallygaropna Lions Club who subsidise a large portion of this program.
- 4. Wreath and Anzac Biscuits (ANZAC Day)** - Philippa Collins has again offered to put together a school wreath for ANZAC Day on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> April. Any donations of flowers for this would be greatly appreciated. The Grade 2/3's will be making Anzac Biscuits on the 21<sup>st</sup> April as well.
- 5. Grade 3/4 Camp** - The Medical Form, the Campers Agreement and the Parental Permission Form are all due now. Students will not be able to attend the camp unless these forms are returned. A reminder that the payment of \$200 needs to be paid by Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April - contact the office if a payment plan is needed. The Curumbene camp is from Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May.
- 6. Cross Country** - This has been confirmed for Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May at Princess Park in Shepparton and students in Grade 5/6 will have an opportunity to participate in this program. As only up to 12 students will attend this day, we will rely on cars for transport. If you can assist let me know ASAP please. I will be taking my car on this day and permission forms will go home soon. There is no cost for this day and we will leave at 12.15pm and return at 3pm.
- 7. Reward Day (Grade 4/5/6)** - Students in the Senior Grade will have an opportunity to participate in a Games Day Reward Program on Wednesday afternoon. Information was put on Tiqbiz over the weekend.
- 8. Cooking with Mrs Forman** - This continues this week and on Tuesday next week and students involved at lunch time are: Chantelle, Savannah, Benjamin, Nicholas, Jade and Lilly on Thursday and Tom, Josh, Declan J, Jimmy, Lachlan and Jai next Tuesday.
- 9. Public Holiday / Newsletter** - Monday is ANZAC Day and is a Public Holiday so no students will be required at school. School will resume on Tuesday next week and the newsletter will go home then. The ANZAC Day Service at Shepparton begins at 11am and our school will be represented on this day. All Grade 4/5/6 students should be preparing for this now and they have had scripts for the last month to assist them with this process. We hope to announce the cast in a couple of weeks' time.
