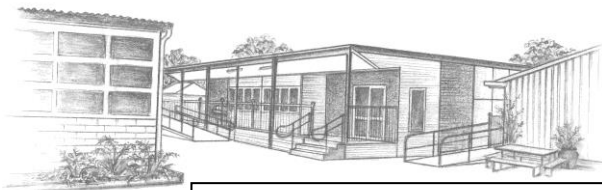

4. School Hats - A couple of years ago, we were able to adjust our Sun Smart Policy in line with accreditation in regard to being a Sun Smart School.
