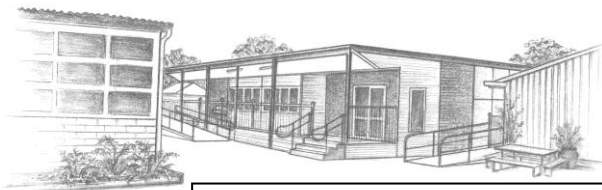

- 1. Hats (SunSmart Policy)** - Today was the first day that all students and teachers were required to wear hats again. This measure is in line with our SunSmart Policy. **Children without a hat will only be allowed to play under the large undercover area.**
- 2. Cooking Day (Father's Day)** - This will be held this Wednesday in the Multipurpose Room. Cost for the session is \$3 (ingredients and gift) just to cover costs. Please send money to school ASAP. If anyone has a spare couple of hours to help our kids with cooking please contact Bev Montgomery, Jill McFarlane or Karen at the office.
- 3. Footy Colours Day** - This will be held on Friday and involves a gold coin donation for each family who participate. Students wishing to participate can come in their footy colours and jumpers. Students who choose not to participate will require normal school uniform. Junior School Council will run some fun footy activities in the afternoon.
- 4. School Review** - On Monday 15th September, all teachers will be involved in a School Review Panel Day. There will be no school assembly in the morning of the 15th September. This assembly will be held on Tuesday 16th September at 9am. School will run as per normal on the School Review day but grades will be split (F-2, 3-6), so that all staff can be involved in this process.
- 5. Fun Run** - This will be held on Thursday 11th September. We will leave school at 10.20pm and return to school by 2pm. The cost for the day is \$2 to cover the bus and students can have a sausage sizzle lunch order for an extra \$2 (ORDERS MUST BE IN BY TOMORROW). Children are asked to bring food and drink which can be disposed of on this day ie paper bag instead of lunch box.
- 6. Emergency Management (Bus)** - A reminder to families who utilise the school bus in the morning or the afternoon to join the Emergency Management (Bus) box on Tiqbiz. Thanks to those families who have done this already so that our emergency procedures in relation to the bus can be smooth.
- 7. End of Year Excursion** - Numbers are filling up fast for the End of Year Excursion to Melbourne in December. We need all numbers by the end of the term so could you contact the office ASAP to confirm your spot. Information has been provided in past editions of the newsletter and on Tiqbiz.
- 8. School Production** - Information went home via the newsletter regarding costumes and props for our School Production on Wednesday 10th September.
