3. ANZAC Day – This formal ceremony will be held tomorrow at Welsford Street in Shepparton. Our 4 school leaders will be in attendance to present a wreath to acknowledge the ultimate sacrifice made by our diggers. Students will need to be there at 10.30am for an 11am start (school uniform required) and Hayley McDonald and Tori Puetz will be in attendance to assist with the day. All students and families are welcome to attend if they wish. There will also be a wreath laying ceremony at 11.30am at the Tallygaroopna Soldiers Memorial Hall and a BBQ lunch will be provided by the Lions Club. Donations will go to the Royal Children's Hospital and Tea and Coffee will also be available. School will resume on Wed 26th April after the Anzac Day Public Holiday.

11. Annual Report – We anticipate that this will be available to the school community in the next few weeks. This includes reflecting on the school's performance and explaining the impact of school improvement efforts on student outcomes.

12. Open Days – We have scheduled 7 Open Days for Term 2 for prospective families and students. Please promote these dates as much as possible – these will be on all school communication platforms. We hope to have an idea of enrolments for 2024 by the end of Term 2 – this will assist with planning and staffing for the new year.

13. Professional Practice Days – The Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022 provides teachers with two professional practice days in 2023 and one professional practice day in 2024 and beyond. We will be aiming for these to not be pupil free days – further information will be available soon.

14. Transition – A number of items are being sent home with Grade 6 students in regard to Open Days...etc at specific Secondary Schools for 2024. Please follow these up and contact relevant schools as needed.

15. School Hats – Our Sun Smart Policy states that children will be required to wear Cancer Council approved close-weave broad brimmed hats (at least 8 cm rigid brim) whenever they are outside from mid-August to the end of April. Therefore, hats will be required for the 1st week back only.

16. Canberra Camp – This camp is planned for Grade 5/6 students in Term 4 from Monday 23rd October to Thursday 26th October. Families are encouraged to make regular payments to assist with the overall cost of this camp. We anticipate that this camp will be about \$400 - \$450 per student subject to fundraising.

17. School Photos – These are scheduled for Friday 19th May. Envelopes will go home soon and these must be returned before the photo day. Further information has been sent out via Skool Loop in regard to specific packages and payments for families.

18. Outdoor Furniture – This is currently being touched up by the Mens Shed and we hope to have this returned to our school during the next few days.

19. Parents' Club Meeting – The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 3rd May straight after school – all are welcome as per usual.

20. GRIP Conference – Our school leaders (Fenn, Jodie, Kade and Liam) will attend this day with students from other schools on Tuesday 9th May – permission forms will go home. Mr Brodie will be attending this conference as well.
