- 11. Annual Report We anticipate that this will be available to the school community in the next few weeks. You will be able to access this here. The Annual Report provides principals and school councils with an opportunity to share the year's achievements and progress with the school community. This includes reflecting on the school's performance and explaining the impact of school improvement efforts on student outcomes.
- 12. Open Days We have scheduled 7 Open Days for Term 2 for prospective families and students. Please promote these dates as much as possible these will be on all school communication platforms. We hope to have an idea of enrolments for 2024 by the end of Term 2 this will assist with planning and staffing for the new year.
- 13. Professional Practice Days The Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022 provides teachers with two professional practice days in 2023 and one professional practice day in 2024 and beyond. We will be aiming for these to not be pupil free days further information will be available soon.
- 14. Transition A number of items are being sent home with Grade 6 students in regard to Open Days...etc at specific Secondary Schools for 2024. Please follow these up and contact relevant schools as needed.
- <u>15. School Hats</u> Our Sun Smart Policy states that children will be required to wear Cancer Council approved close-weave broad brimmed hats (at least 8 cm rigid brim) whenever they are outside from mid-August to the end of April. Therefore, hats will be required for the 1st week back only.
