1. Year 6 to 7 Application Forms – Last week information was sent home to Grade 6 families in regard to application for 6 to 7 placements for 2024 (for placement of Year 6 children in 2023 to Year 7 in 2024). One booklet (15 pages) can be left at home but the 9 page document that was sent home needs to be returned to Tallygaroopna PS by Friday 12th May. This is for both Government and Non Government Schools (Catholic and Independent). Please contact our school to get VSN numbers which are required ASAP. All of this specific information was put on Skool Loop last week.

2. Open Days – We have scheduled 7 Open Days for Term 2 for prospective families and students – the first of these days is tomorrow. Please promote these dates as much as possible – these are now on all school communication platforms. We hope to have an idea of enrolments for 2024 by the end of Term 2 – this will assist with planning and staffing for the new year.

3. Curriculum Days – Just a reminder to families that we have scheduled two Report Writing Days (Curriculum Days) on the following days:

Term 2: Friday 9th June (in line with the King's Birthday Public Holiday on Mon 12th June)

Term 4: Monday 6th Nov (in line with the Melbourne Cup Public Holiday on Tues 7th Nov).
