

- 1. Parents' Club Catering Thanks to the Parents who helped out with catering at the Tallygaroopna Football & Netball Club Ball on Saturday Night. Your assistance is greatly appreciated and this was a successful night.
- 2. Division Athletics Congratulations to the students who participated in the Division Athletics last Friday. We were fortunate to have all of the 9 students who qualified, participate in this program and this experience will hold them in good stead going forward. The Hume Region Athletics Carnival is scheduled for Friday 14th October at Albury.
- 3. Cluster Performance (Aladdin) This will be held at Shepparton (Bourchier St. PS hall) on Wednesday 8th June and the cost for the program is \$10 per student which covers the play (\$8) and the bus (\$2). Permission forms will go home this week, but we will depart school at 12.30pm and return at approximately 3pm. Obviously, with 64 students at our school we are in need of some students not utilising the bus. We are in need of about 10 students to travel by car and the cost will only be \$8.

This is always a great event for our school and the children really look forward to seeing their special friends on this day. - 5. Principals Conference I will be away from Wednesday lunchtime until the end of the week at a Principals Conference in Melbourne. Many other Principals from local schools will be in attendance at this meeting as we keep up to date with current developments in the Education Department.
- 6. Open Days The next Open Day will be this Wednesday morning for prospective families. The last 2 Open Days are scheduled for June 7<sup>th</sup> and June 16<sup>th</sup>, but other appointments that suit can be made at the office if needed.
