- 1. 4 Day Lockdown / Restrictions Well done to everyone for handling the Remote & Flexible learning last week and thank you to the many families who returned hard copy packs so that attendance could be marked for this period. There are still a few restrictions in place for the time being, which are displayed at the front and back gates of the school. The major restrictions in place involve the following:
  - Non-essential visitors should be excluded from school sites for this period. This includes parents and carers unless it is absolutely necessary and urgent. If this is the case you will need to ring the school on 58298264 and speak to the Principal. To support contact tracing, parents and carers will need to record their name in the visitor's book at school and wear a facemask for any time they are in the school grounds after speaking directly to the Principal.
  - Drop and Go in the school car park
    - o Drop offs and pickups will occur at the new fence along the path in the car park. Parents and carers will not leave their cars.
    - o Children will be escorted in and out of cars at the beginning and end of the day.
    - If traffic is built up at the car park entry gate, please enter the car park coming from the Post Office end of town to help with traffic flow along Victoria Street. This may involve doing a drive around the block.
- 2. Bike Education Program This amended program began today for students in Grades 3-6. When the program concludes, contact the school so that bikes can be collected at the front of the school. Specific days and times are below:
