**1. Enrolments for 2025** – Can any enrolments for next year be handed into the office by the end of Term 2 please. We are currently trying to plan for next year, but this is a difficult task if we don't know what numbers will be for 2025. If you are planning on leaving the school – please let me know also and confidentiality will be respected. Thanks in anticipation – David.

**2. Uniform Reminder** – A reminder to families to reinforce our school uniform. This should give our students a sense of pride without competition at school. Shorts should be only black without logos and beanies during winter months should be bottle green or red – not footy beanies. Thanks for your cooperation with this matter. Parents may be contacted and letters sent home if we continue to have non-compliance.

**3. Staffing** – Obviously, there are lots of major changes happening to staffing at present which is unprecedented for our school and we will navigate through this difficult period as best as we can. This will be a test of the whole school community's resilience and resolve during this time. Let's stay connected everyone! Please ensure that respect is at the front during this time and it is essential that this is modelled by all of our staff, students and families.

**4. Reports** – We will be aiming to distribute these in sealed envelopes on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June. Teachers spend a lot of valuable time putting these together so please take the time to read them. Remember that these reports can be placed in the green report folders which some students at school may have. These can be purchased from the office for \$15. Further information was in last week's newsletter.

**5. School Council** – The next meeting is scheduled to be held tonight, Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June. Information was sent out last Friday.

**6. Munch N Crunch** – The next lunch for students will be delivered on this Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June (sushi).

**7. Grade 5/6 Teacher** – We were fortunate to have Miss Sait at our school last week, meeting the staff and students of the school. We are aiming to have this occur again one more time before the term break. Miss Sait will begin her time at Tallygaroopna at the beginning of Term 3 on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July and we hope her time at our school is a positive one.

**8. Bike Education** – This will be held for Grade 4, 5 and 6 students on the following days – August 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> plus September 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. More information will be available after the holiday break which will involve permission forms and bike checklists. We anticipate that the Grade 6 students will be involved in a bike ride to conclude this program. Mrs Montgomery has kindly offered to implement this program again in 2024.

**9. Ballarat Camp** – This camp is planned for Grade 5/6 students in Term 4 from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October to Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October. Families are encouraged to make regular payments to assist with the overall cost of this camp. We anticipate that this camp will be about \$400 - \$450 per student subject to fundraising. An Expression of interest form has gone home and this is now due so that final numbers can be confirmed.

**10. End of Term 2** – School will finish for the term on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June at 2.25pm – an hour earlier as per usual. Assembly will be at 2pm on this day and school will resume on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July. A reminder to families who use the OSH Care that this service ceases at 5pm on the last day of each term.

**11. Parent Payment Arrangements for 2024** – These were approved at school council on 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 and are set at \$200 per student for 2024 to cover student supplies, online subscriptions and MACC & MARC costs. Payment can be made by direct bank transfer, cash or cheque. Further details [can be found here](#).

# APPENDIX A: TALLYGAROOPA PS UNIFORM ITEMS

## All year round

The following items may be worn all year round, with either the summer or winter uniform:

### **Bomber Jacket or Windcheater**

Bottle green/red bomber jacket with school logo

Bottle green crew-neck windcheater

### **Polo shirts**

Bottle green short sleeved with school logo. Grade 6 students may wear a red polo shirt with school logo. Bottle green long sleeved polo.

### **Skorts**

Plain black skorts without decoration or brand name and in winter can be worn with black tights/stockings.

### **Socks or tights/stockings**

Black or white socks

Black tights/stockings

### **Footwear**

Appropriate footwear is to be worn. Summer sandals with covered toes, black school shoes or runners are permitted. No thongs or open-toed sandals are permitted.

### **Dresses**

Summer bottle green and white checked dress

### **Shorts**

Plain black shorts **without decoration or brand name**

### **Pants**

Plain, black track pants without decoration or brand name

## **Winter Uniform – can be worn in Term 2 and 3**

### **Skivvies**

Plain bottle green or black skivvy

### **Beanies**

**Plain bottle green or red**

### **Scarves**

**Plain bottle green**

## **Hats – to be worn from mid-August to 30 April**

Bottle green broadbrim or bucket hat without decoration or brand name.

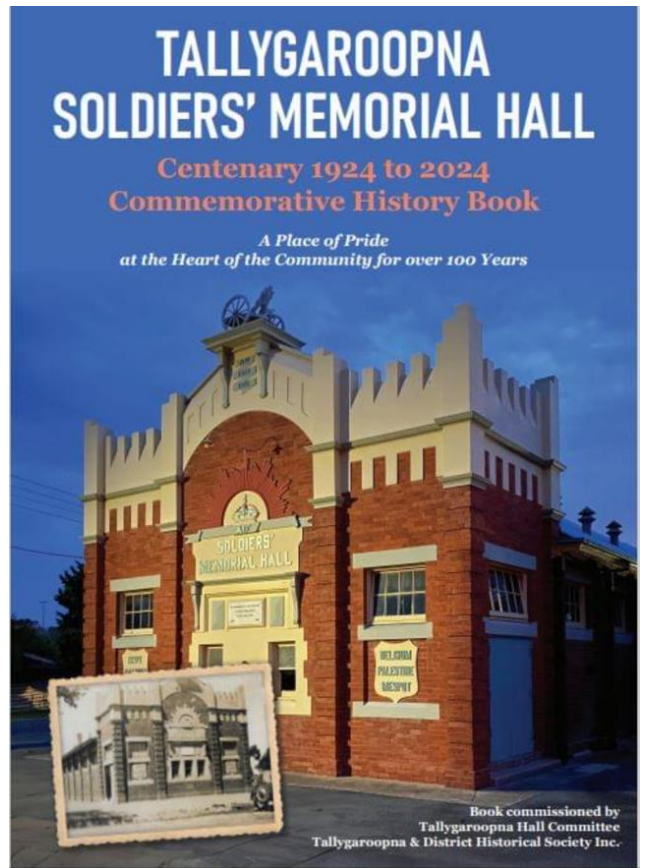
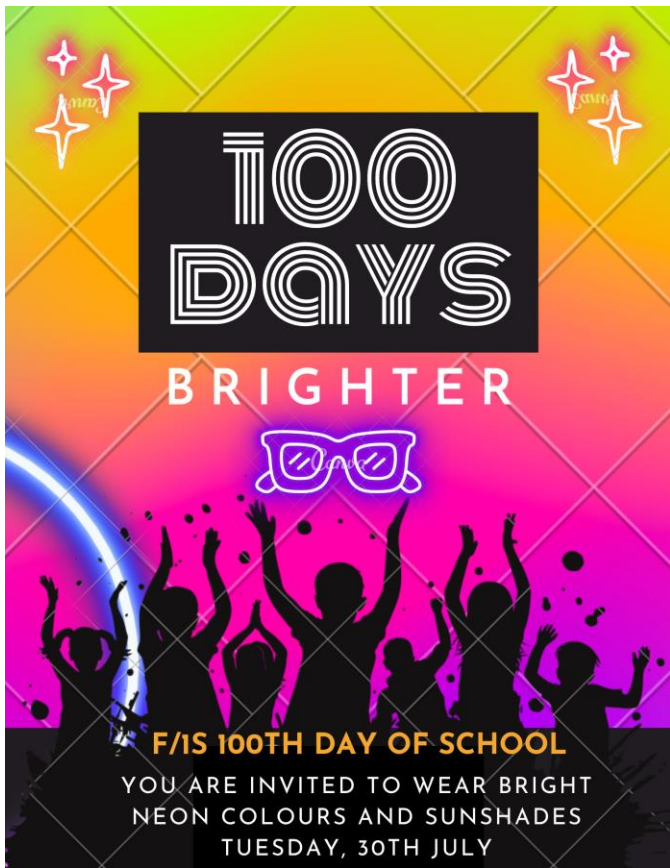

### **Here's some tips to ensure you receive notices and push notifications**

- When you download the Skool Loop App you will be asked if you would like notifications please **tap yes**. Some devices don't ask this question and automatically tick yes for you. This can be changed in your settings
- If your notifications are turned off in your device settings, some phones apply that to all apps when downloading. In the phone settings please make sure your notifications are turned on
- Check your App Store or Google Play regularly for any outstanding updates
- There are 2 different notices school will send out: **push notification** (banner and ding) or a **notice** (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a **notice** has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a **push notification**.
