- 1. Welcome Miss Litzow began her time at Tallygaroopna PS today and I am sure her time here at our school will be both rewarding and enjoyable. I am sure our parents will continue to be supportive for the remainder of the 2018 school year if any issues need addressing consult with me please.
- 2. Attendance Awards These were handed out today at assembly we acknowledge all students who have 95% attendance for each term and semester. As always, our attendance data is outstanding and so far we have 12 students who have had 100% attendance for the year which is a fantastic result.
