- present and are expecting 10 or more which is pleasing. School tours can be made upon request depending on COVID-19 restrictions please continue to promote our school as much as possible because we have a large cohort of Grade 6 students leaving the school at the end of the year.
- 2. Remote & Flexible Learning Learning materials were available last Wednesday at 5pm for 4 days concluding on Tuesday 27th July (these included a black book, hard copy sheets and a glue stick). Remote & Flexible Learning continues today and the school community will be informed of further updates ASAP.
- 3. Get Active To help support your children to stay active while learning from home, families can access a range of free COVIDSafe ideas to stay active and games through Get Active Victoria.
- 4. Mental Health & Wellbeing Resources It can be challenging to process and manage changes to routines and the uncertainty that comes with COVID-19 and related restrictions - including moving to remote learning. A Quick Guide to Student Mental Health and Wellbeing resources is available for students, parents and carers looking to access expert guidance and resources to support wellbeing.
- 5. Parent Opinion Survey This will be distributed to families in a hard copy form and also via Skool Loop when things ease off hopefully with Remote & Flexible learning. It would be appreciated if 1 person from each family completed this survey – this can be done anytime up to Sunday 22nd August.
- 6. Attendance R & F Learning All students will be recorded as being present during remote learning unless advised otherwise. If students are not completing work given or participating in Webex sessions - please do a Skool Loop absence for any of these days as per normal. If there is no evidence that a student has participated in Webex sessions or completed the supplied work, they will be remarked as absent once normal schooling resumes. Your assistance with this would be appreciated. If normal schooling resumes on Wednesday can black books with any set work be returned to school please so that these can be stored for the
- 7. On Site Supervision / Borrowing Netbooks Please adhere to any deadlines regarding On Site Supervision Forms some are still coming in late and this doesn't help when trying to organise staffing for supervision. Please be respectful of this. Families will receive a text message when these forms have been received. If families still need to borrow a netbook contact me via text message please (see above) so that this can be organised - keep in mind that I may not be at school on certain days during Remote & Flexible learning.
- 8. Father's Day Breakfast This is scheduled to be held on Monday 30th August more information will go out when we return to normal on site learning. Families and carers should pencil this date in.
- 9. School Production These performances will go ahead as scheduled on Thursday 26th August and Friday 27th August (evening show). What these shows look like will be determined by COVID-19 restrictions, but some possibilities are listed below.
 - ${\bf 1}.$ Performances will be at the hall with no limit on people allowed in the hall
 - Performances will be at the hall with restrictions in place with people allowed at the hall a ticketing process would be implemented.
 - 3. Performances will be at the hall with no crowd this will be recorded for families to purchase if they wish.

The final audience format will be sent out as soon as it is known. The school will take no responsibility for families not being aware of this information.

- 11. Grade 5/6 Camp We are currently looking into other options rather than the Grade 5/6 Camp to Canberra from feedback received. As you could appreciate there is a lot of uncertainty going interstate in regard to restrictions with COVID-19. There is also the financial burden that families would have to face if this camp was cancelled. We hope to have a further update in the next few weeks.
- 12. Expression of Interest (3/4 Camp) This was sent home a couple of weeks ago and also put on Skool Loop for the Grade 3/4 Camp to Echuca. This is now due, so that a decision can be made on whether this program will run.
- 13. Chaplain / Consent Forms Tim Ford will be at our school on Monday and Wednesday this week. A reminder to families to get consent forms in ASAP, so that students can interact with Tim in small groups or individually. These were sent home with report envelopes before the end of Term 2.
- 14. New Goals If we return to school on Wednesday these will be distributed to families in a sealed envelope on Friday 30th July.
- 15. Mrs Fitzpatrick Sadly Mrs Fitz could not say goodbye to her class a couple of weeks ago. As a result, Mrs Fitz will pop in when school returns.
- 16. Assembly At present, this will be held via Webex on Friday at 3pm unless restrictions change.
