- 1. The Matildas How good was Saturday night? Although, I am sure that everyone was on the edge of their seat with that long penalty shootout. Fingers crossed the girls get the job done on Wednesday night and make it to the World Cup Final - stay tuned for more information.
- 2. Parent Opinion Survey The Parent, Caregiver and Guardian Opinion Survey for 2023 is now available to complete online until Friday 8th September. The survey seeks feedback on school climate, student engagement and teaching practices for student engagement outcomes. Instructions for how to complete the survey, and a link for the online survey portal went home last week in a formal letter for each family. If you have misplaced this - contact the school and a new one will be sent home.
- 3. Enrolments for 2024 If your child will not be at our school for 2024, can families please contact the office. This will assist with planning for the new year - at present we are not aware of any current students not being at our school next year, apart from our Grade 6 students. We currently have 10 enrolments for new Foundations for 2024 which is fantastic. If any enrolment forms are still outstanding please return them ASAP. We anticipate that we will be having an extensive Transition program again in Term 4 which will involve possibly 5 school days - these dates will be released soon.
- 4. AFL 9s We anticipate that permission forms will go home this week for F-6 students for this day which will be held at Congupna on Friday 8th September. This day is FREE and will be a Footy Colours Day also - organised by AFL Goulburn Murray. The F/1/2 students will be at Congupna Primary School taking part in AFL / Netball Victoria Primary Play sessions while the 3/4/5/6 students will be at the Congupna Football Oval at the AFL 9s tournament. We look forward to a fun filled day.

- 5. School Hats In line with our Sun Smart Policy, school hats are again mandated by mid-August. Therefore, we will be enforcing Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> August. Please reinforce this at home.
- **6. TwistED Science Excursion** F/1/2/3/4 students will attend a free excursion at Echuca on Monday 11th September and we anticipate that permission forms will go home this week. We will leave school by bus at 8.30am so that we can be at the TwistED Science venue by 10am for our first session. All students will need to bring their normal lunch, snack and drink for this day and school uniform is required along with school hats. We anticipate that 4 members of staff will be attending this day and the bus will be at capacity. We anticipate returning to school by 2.30pm.
- 7. Canberra Camp This camp is planned for Grade 5/6 students in Term 4 from Mon 23rd Oct to Thurs 26th Oct. Information was sent home a number of weeks ago and is also available via Skool Loop – to be returned no later than Fri 8<sup>th</sup> Sept which gives families plenty of time to make specific medical appointments if needed.

The cost for this camp has been set - \$400. A huge thank you to the school community for the fundraising that has occurred for this opportunity and we look forward to doing the same in 2 years time for more students. Families are encouraged to make regular payments to ensure that their fee is fully paid prior to the start of the camp.

8. Grade 1/2 Activity Night – This is scheduled for this Friday 18th August. This will involve some fun activities after school, followed by a pizza tea and then a sleepover for Grade 2 students. Specific forms that went home weeks ago are now due. Grade 1 and 2 students can arrive back at school at 5pm and Grade 1 students need to be picked up by 7.30pm on Friday night. On Saturday morning, Grade 2 students need to be picked up by 7.30am. Please be prompt with these drop off and pick up times.

- If your notifications are turned off in your device settings, some phones apply that to all apps
  when downloading. In the phone settings please make sure your notifications are turned on
- · Check your App Store or Google Play regularly for any outstanding updates
- There are 2 different notices school will send out: push notification (banner and ding) or a notice (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- · If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a notice has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a push notification.
