1. Planning for 2024 – We are currently in the process of pursuing a 4th classroom teacher for the new year. This is being actively advertised on Recruitment Online and other communication channels as needed (i.e. Facebook). Unfortunately, we could not fill this teaching position last year because of recruitment difficulties. We hope we have more success this year – stay tuned. Please promote our school in a positive manner to assist with this process.

2. Production Costume List – This was distributed a couple of weeks ago for our school Production and your attention here would be appreciated – this is available on Skool Loop also. Please contact Miss Parry if you need anything clarified, but it would be appreciated if these start coming into school this week.

3. Bunnings BBQ – This day is scheduled for Sunday 8th October and the BBQ will run from 8am until 5pm. We are looking for some helpers on this day and this is an opportunity for some families to assist if they don't have time throughout the normal school week. Information is on Skool Loop and a roster will be updated regularly via Skool Loop.

4. Swimming Program – Permission forms were distributed last week and this program will be held from Mon. 16th Oct to Fri. 20th Oct (free for all students). Sessions will be from 12.30pm – 1.15pm and then 1.15pm – 2pm (there was a small error on the permission form times). We anticipate that junior students will swim first (changed at school), followed by senior students and we aim to return to school by 2.30pm. Children not participating will be supervised at school by staff and complete some Water Safety activities.

5. School Council – Our next meeting is tonight - Monday 4th September. Information was sent to members last Thursday.

6. Parent Opinion Survey – This is still available to complete online until Friday 8th September. Instructions for how to complete the survey, and a link for the online survey portal went home a few weeks ago in a formal letter for each family. If you have misplaced this – contact the school and a new one will be sent home. So far we have had only 25% of families participate so some more feedback would be appreciated.

7. Enrolments for 2024 – If your child will not be at our school for 2024, can families please contact the office. This will assist with planning for the new year – at present we are not aware of any current students not being at our school next year, apart from our Grade 6 students

8. Twisted Science Excursion – F/1/2/3/4 students will attend a free excursion at Echuca on Monday 11th Sept - permission forms went home a few weeks ago. We will leave school by bus at 8.30am so that we can be at the Twisted Science venue by 10am for our first session. All students will need to bring their normal lunch, snack and drink for this day and school uniform is required along with school hats. We anticipate that 4 members of staff will be attending this day and the bus will be at capacity. We anticipate returning to school by 2.30pm.

9. AFL 9s – Permission forms for F-6 students are now due. This day will be held at Congupna on Friday 8th Sept and is FREE (Footy Colours Day), organised by AFL Goulburn Murray. The F/1/2 students will be at Congupna Primary School taking part in AFL / Netball Victoria Primary Play sessions while the 3/4/5/6 students will be at the Congupna Football Oval at the AFL 9s tournament. We look forward to a fun filled day and aim to return to school by 2.30pm.

We anticipate being down the hall a little bit next week in preparation for our big night on Tuesday 12th October. Lights and sound will be set up at the Tallygaroopna Hall on Monday 11th September and a last practice matinee will be available to view on Tuesday 12th September during the day.


For his outstanding resilience and willingness to have a go, he participated in all Bike Ed activities and won nearest the pin in golf. Super proud, mate!

Here's some tips to ensure you receive notices and push notifications

- When you download the Skool Loop App you will be asked if you would like notifications please **tap yes**. Some devices don't ask this question and automatically tick yes for you. This can be changed in your settings
- If your notifications are turned off in your device settings, some phones apply that to all apps when downloading. In the phone settings please make sure your notifications are turned on
- Check your App Store or Google Play regularly for any outstanding updates
- There are 2 different notices school will send out: **push notification** (banner and ding) or a **notice** (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a **notice** has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a **push notification**.
