1. School Improvement Program

Last week, I met with Ashley Bicknell and finalised signage that will be put up around the school. We are hopeful that this will occur during the holiday break. I also met with Water Plus in regard to our irrigation around the school and Col Wilcox who will assist us with the redevelopment of the car park. This week our basketball / netball rings should go up and we are looking at getting a synthetic cricket pitch on the school oval which will allow students to play in this area after the holiday break.

Some more shelving, hanging racks and our new school noticeboard should also arrive in the next few weeks which will further enhance our new school buildings.

2. Undercover Area – Off Limits

Over the weekend, pavers were removed in the Undercover Area outside the multi purpose room. We anticipate that this area will be concreted during the school holidays and this area has been sealed off and is off limits to students at school. Please reinforce this at home. 3. End of Year Excursion

In 2010, we had a successful end of year excursion to the Melbourne Zoo and we are hopeful of doing the same again this year. This has been discussed at School Council and at the Parents Club Meeting last Wednesday night but <u>a</u> <u>possible date may be either Thursday 8th or 15th December to a venue to be determined</u>. Two venues have been discussed so far – Luna Park and the Whittlesea Fun Park and I will be working out specific costs for the two and presenting them to the Parents Club first week back after the holidays before a final date and venue is confirmed.

Last year, parents were invited to come along with their respective children at school. At this stage, no Preschool children will be invited because we would like parents to see this trip as an opportunity to spend some quality time with their children who are presently enrolled at Tallygaroopna PS. We hope to confirm this event and specific costs before the end of the term so stay tuned.

4. NAPLAN Results

These results were put in sealed envelopes and sent to parents last week for children in Grades 3 and 5. Teachers will be having a closer look at this on Thursday. If any parents would like to discuss these results further please contact classroom teachers. It is important to remember that these tests are one off and are not a true reflection of student performance at school. Some students have difficulty in test situations with strict time limits, so this needs to be taken into consideration.

5. Swimming Program

Our Swimming Program has concluded and it was very successful with children reinforcing skills associated with water familiarisation, safety and stroke technique. We anticipate that Swimming Certificates will be available early next term – these will be photocopied for Student Files and will also go home.

6. Last Day of Term 3 / Hats


15. You Can Do It Awards
