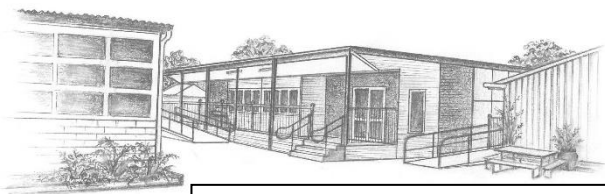

### MINI NEWSLETTER

- 1. Return to School** - Unfortunately, all students will continue with Remote & Flexible learning for the remainder of Term 3. There will be a staged return to onsite learning for all students in term 4 and we will await for further directions from the Education Department in regard to this. As a result, current arrangements will continue until Term 3 finishes on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September with an early dismissal at 2.25pm as per usual.
- 2. Hats** - In line with our Sun Smart program, hats are now mandated. Any students and staff on site, will now need their school hat.
- 3. Father's Day** - Hopefully all of the dads, pops, uncles, carers and special friends had a great day yesterday and were spoilt.
- 4. Swimming Program** - We have been informed that there will be no Swimming Program at Aquamoves for 2020. We hope to resume this program again in 2021 subject to COVID-19 restrictions.
- 5. Planning for 2021** - To assist us with our planning, can you please let the school know of any students in Foundation to Year 5 that will NOT be attending TPS next year. We would appreciate if you could let us know as soon as possible via email or phone - confidentiality will be respected.
- 6. Student Led Conferences** - Thanks to the many families who organised phone calls with our class teachers last Tuesday. This was obviously not ideal, but was certainly appreciated as we try our best to maintain the school and home relationship during this difficult time.
- 7. Remote & Flexible Learning / COVID-19** - A reminder that whole class activities will continue to be held via Webex on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and hard copies of work can be collected each Sunday from 5pm. Please use hand sanitiser before returning or collecting materials. There will be a variety of information made available on Class Dojo (weekly tasks to complete), so please access this resource as often as possible. Please remember that our students are not required to work their normal school hours. Also remember that if they are finding something tricky or not in the right mindset, step away, take a break and come back to it later. Try and be positive as much as possible because our behaviours play a big part in regard to the self-esteem and morale of our whole school community.
- 8. Submitting Attendance / Returning Work** - Parents will continue to notify weekly attendance by sending only one email to the school email address by 3pm each Friday. Families may do this before Friday if they wish - please notify via school email if any changes occur (there is no need to use Skool Loop). If students do not attend Webex sessions or return hard copy work, this will be followed up by classroom teachers on an individual basis. A reminder to families to hand in work completed for the week in one named stapled bundle and placed in the plastic pocket it came in so that they can be reused. As much as possible, tasks should be completed on the specified days so that Webex sessions are purposeful and building on previous work.
