1. Planning for 2024 – We are currently in the process of pursuing a 4th classroom teacher for the new year. This is being actively advertised on Recruitment Online and other communication channels as needed (ie. Facebook). Unfortunately, we could not fill this teaching position last year because of recruitment difficulties. We hope we have more success this year – stay tuned. Please promote our school in a positive manner to assist with this process.

2. Production Day – All students are required to be at the hall **by 6.30pm on Tuesday night**. We will be aiming to begin our night performance at 7pm and we hope that the night will conclude just after 8pm. A big thank you to the sponsors who have assisted with our Production Raffle. This will be drawn on the night, so please get raffle tickets in before 7pm.

3. Production Costume List – This was distributed a couple of weeks ago – this is available on Skool Loop also. Please contact Miss Parry if you need anything clarified.

4. Bunnings BBQ – This day is scheduled for Sunday 8th October and the BBQ will run from 8am until 5pm. We are looking for some helpers on this day and this is an opportunity for some families to assist if they don't have time throughout the normal school week. 5. Tutoring Program – The Victorian Government has announced a further \$442.2 million investment to extend the Tutor Learning Initiative for the 2024 and 2025 school years. This funding will allow Victorian government schools to continue to provide students with intensive small-group tutoring support. Further details will be available towards the end of the year. Melissa Beer is currently our Tutor who is at school each Monday.

6. Cancellation – AFL 9's – Unfortunately, this day was cancelled last Friday because of bad weather. There is a possibility that this day may be rescheduled to early Term 4. Stay tuned for more details – we hope that if this occurs the Hot Dog orders would be followed through on this day.

7. Assembly / Terrific Kids – Assembly this week will be held at 2pm this Friday and we are again looking forward to presenting Terrific Kids awards to two outstanding students at our school.

8. Attendance Awards – Term 3 – Students who have been able to maximum their learning with 95% attendance or more in Term 3 will be acknowledged at assembly on Friday. Certificates will also be handed out for these students.

9. Swimming Program – Permission forms were distributed a couple of weeks ago for this program to be held from Mon. 16th Oct to Fri. 20th Oct (free for all students). Sessions will be from 12.45pm – 1.30pm and then 1.30pm – 2.15pm (there was a small error on the permission form times). We anticipate that junior students will swim first (changed at school), followed by senior students and we aim to return to school by 2.45pm. Children not participating will be supervised at school by staff and complete some Water Safety activities.

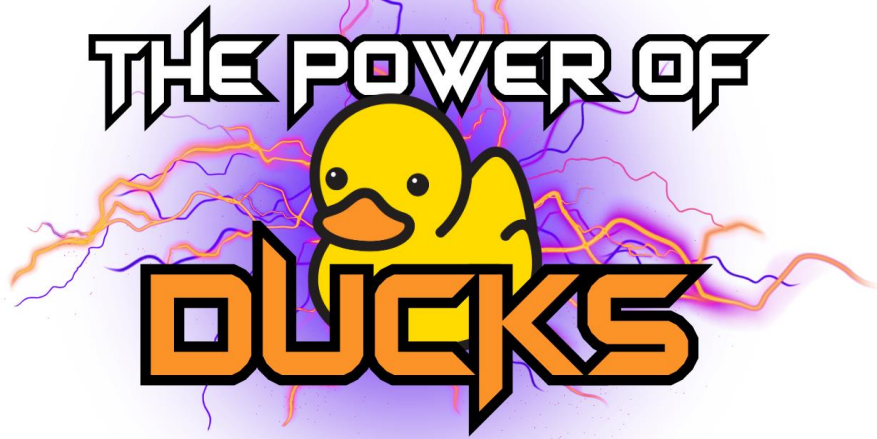

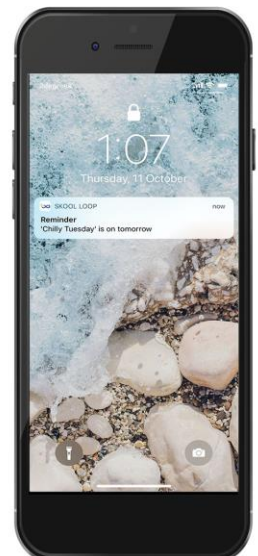

Here's some tips to ensure you receive notices and push notifications

- When you download the Skool Loop App you will be asked if you would like notifications please **tap yes**. Some devices don't ask this question and automatically tick yes for you. This can be changed in your settings
- If your notifications are turned off in your device settings, some phones apply that to all apps when downloading. In the phone settings please make sure your notifications are turned on
- Check your App Store or Google Play regularly for any outstanding updates
- There are 2 different notices school will send out: **push notification** (banner and ding) or a **notice** (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a **notice** has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a **push notification**.
