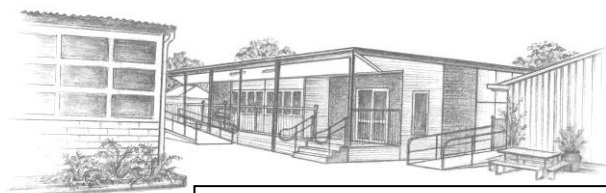

**1. Lunch Orders** - We had our first lunch orders from the Servo last week and by all accounts they were thoroughly enjoyed! As a result of this, no pie warmers will be implemented in Term 4 - these are strictly for the colder months in Terms 2 and 3.

**2. Swimming Program** - Our Annual Swimming Program will begin on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> October and conclude on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October. Students will swim from 11am until noon each day and the cost for the program is \$52 per student. We will travel by bus leaving at 10.30am and return to school by 12.30pm approximately. Permission forms have more specific details - these need to be returned ASAP. Students who are not participating will still need to travel to Aquamoves on the Monday and Friday but will be able to stay back at school with a teacher for the rest of the week.

**4. OSH Care** - is on this week on Wednesday - Mrs W, Thursday/Friday - Mrs H, for any interested families. Enrolment forms must be handed in to participate in this program.

**6. First Aid in School Program** - Our whole school will be participating in this program this Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> October. Each grade will attend specific sessions before lunchtime.
