2. Staffing for 2016

After a lengthy process, we are pleased to announce that 2 new staff members will be joining our staff for 2016 in a full time class teaching capacity. Ms Melissa Beer has been appointed as our junior teacher and Ms Ashley Triffett has been appointed as our Senior Class Teacher. At present, Melissa will be teaching the F/1 class and Ashley will be teaching the students in Grades 4/5/6. We are fortunate to retain Mrs Haberfield as a member of staff and Claire will be teaching Grade 2/3. I will be finally relinquishing full time teaching duties and assisting Claire with mentoring and coaching our two new young and enthusiastic teachers. There may be some more staffing announcements made before the end of year as well so stay tuned.

At present, our numbers for 2016 are approaching 60 and if any changes are needed in regard to the classroom structures for next year, parents will be informed ASAP. There is the possibility that some more Foundation students may join our school early next year, so this may alter initial plans.

We are holding a mini fete in conjunction with the Northerners Cricket Club on Melbourne Cup Day on Tuesday 3rd of November from 11.30am until 1.30pm. This is our last major fundraiser for the year. 4. End of Year Excursion

Planning for the trip to Whittlesea Fun Fields is progressing well and we can confirm that this day will be held on Thursday 3rd December. The Parents Club have kindly offered to fund the costs for buses for all students and parents. They have also agreed to subsidise \$7 off the cost of entry to Fun Fields for students. As a result, tickets will be \$15 for students and \$22 for parents / guardians. This can be paid to the office now. This day is strictly for students of the school and parents / guardians. If families wish to bring other siblings other arrangements will need to be made in regard to travel and entry to Fun Fields – but please consult with the School Principal in regard to this.

5. OSH Care Days - 2016

We are starting to discuss what days we may be implementing OSH Care for 2016. At present, these days are on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 3.25pm until 6pm, but they are open to change. If you could return the form in this newsletter it would be greatly appreciated so that adequate planning can take place for next year. At present, we have had a limited response in regard to this so currently the days will remain the same on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. However, this is still subject to change depending on family needs.

8. Orientation Program – starts tomorrow

Information is provided in this edition of the newsletter regarding our Orientation Program for new Foundation students for 2016. Could all relevant families please put these dates into your calendar – it is important that children attend the majority of these sessions so that they can begin schooling in a positive way. Any queries contact the school ASAP please.

9. Curriculum Days

The last 2 curriculum days (pupil free) for the school year have been formally approved by School Council. These will be held on Monday 2nd November and Friday 4th December. The Curriculum day in November will be before the Public Holiday for the Melbourne Cup, thus giving families a 4 day weekend. The last pupil free day for the year will be held after the End of Year Excursion in Melbourne. On both of these days, there will be no Sporting Schools Program (sport) or Outside School Hours Care (OSH). Families are encouraged to make arrangements for both of these days now. As per normal, all schools are able to hold 4 Curriculum Days (Pupil Free) per year. Our first 2 days were used at the start of the year – CPR Update / Start of the year organisation & Report Writing. The Student Led Conference Day was not an official curriculum day because all children came into school on this day. This was endorsed at School Council.

10. Lunch Orders

The first lunch orders were processed smoothly last Thursday. Thanks to everyone for assisting for this. A reminder that these are available every Thursday, with lunch orders due at school on Wednesday at 3.30pm. Lunch order pricelists have been sent home and are on Tigbiz.

11. Earn and Learn Program

As you know, our school has been participating in the Woolworths Earn & Learn program. The program has now finished for this year, so a big thanks to everyone who supported our school. We have earned 5,640 points with this program and we will be consulting with students in regard to purchases for this program soon.

12. Swimming Program

We again have had a fantastic response in regard to this program with almost all students participating in this extra curricula activity. Our Swimming Program is scheduled to be held from Monday 19th October until Friday 23rd October (week 3 – term 4). This program is not included in school fees and it is a voluntary program, if children wish to participate. Generally, this program is of great value considering what it would cost for 5 hours of swimming lessons normally. This year, we will be swimming for 5 days straight and all students will participate in an hour program daily. All students will swim from 11am until noon each day. Each day we will leave school at 10.30am and return at approximately 12.30pm. The cost for the program is \$55 per student, which covers bus costs, swimming instructors and entry to Aquamoves in Shepparton. This is only a small increase from last year's program. This money will need to be paid by Wednesday 14th October – permission forms have gone out and must be returned ASAP also.

13. Division / Region Athletics

Harvey, Kyle, Declan, Eloise, Daniel and Jordan represented the school at McEwen Reserve today at the Division Athletics. The cost was \$10 per student – to be paid to the school. We hope to have an update about their progress ASAP. Regional Athletics will be held on Friday 16th October if students' progress to the next level. Parents will be again responsible for travel arrangements if this eventuates.

14. Enrolments

We have had a fantastic response to enrolments for new Foundation Students for 2016. At present, we have 13 Enrolment Forms handed in and we may be awaiting a couple more as well. Your assistance in regard to this would be greatly appreciated.

15. Sporting Schools Program

Our Sporting Schools Program continues again next week. As per usual, sessions after school begin at 3.35pm and will finish at 4.35pm. Students receive a healthy snack before the program begins for all school sessions. Students need to be picked up immediately after each session. The Shepparton Ten Pin Bowling sessions will involve students catching a bus from school and then this will return back to school at about 5.15pm. If parents would like to come on the bus contact the school to see if room is available. Students can be picked up from Shepparton if needed – just let the school know ASAP please.



We recommend all families arrange ambulance cover in case of emergency. There are also a variety of commercial insurance policies available that would cover accidents at school.

17. Bunnings BBQ

Thanks to the many families who assisted with the BBQ yesterday and we anticipate that we again raised about \$1,000 which will go towards Buildings and Grounds and general maintenance around the school. A formal announcement about the amount will be made in the near future.
