News from the Principal's Desk

Hi evervone.

Unfortunately, the wet weather has continued on from last term and our school grounds have been affected greatly. At present, no students are allowed on the school oval until it dries up and we will continue to monitor the school grounds to make sure our school is safe and secure for everyone in our school community. Again, cricket is planned for most Friday's after school but this will be delayed unfortunately.

All students and staff made a welcome return to classroom activities last week. This term promises to be an exciting one with many extra curricula activities taking place and the highlights will undoubtedly be the 2 Senior Camps and the 2 Excursions to the Science Works and the Whittlesea Fun Fields. Please be prompt with any specific forms which are needed in regard to these programs because it takes a lot of time, effort and planning for all of these to be organised effectively.

At present, we look like having 70 students at our school for 2017. This is an all-time high during my tenure at school and we are currently in discussions with a number of other families which is great news. Therefore, I can officially announce that we will be having a 4th classroom for next year. More great announcements are planned over the next few weeks. The Grade Structures for next year have also been announced in this edition of the newsletter and we have decided to split the Grade 1's in 2017 - being the largest grade in the school. This will then allow us to have relative consistent and low class numbers across the whole school. In determining whether these children are in the F/1 or 1/2 class many factors will be looked at. Among these will be the academic and social level of the students in this year level and we will endeavour to do what we think is best for this cohort of children. 2. Enrolments / Grade Structures for 2017

At present, we look like beginning the new year with 70 students which is a great result for our school. Therefore, we will be having a 4th classroom in 2017 and we are currently working on grade placements which we hope to confirm in the next couple of weeks. The grade structure for 2017 will be the following, but class numbers may change with any future alterations to enrolments.

Foundation / Grade 1 – 17 students
Grade 1 / Grade 2 – 17 students

Senior School
Grade 3 / Grade 4 – 16 students
Grade 5 / Grade 6 – 20 students

We are over the moon, that we can again offer low classroom sizes across the whole school. This will obviously make our school an attractive learning environment for the future. If you would like to discuss grade placements for Grade 1 students could you see Mr Brodie ASAP please.

3. Staffing Process / New Classes

We are about to finish the staffing process, for class teachers for the new year. These will be announced in a fortnight's time and we thank everyone for their patience with this matter. We anticipate having all of our classroom teachers for 2017 attend the Statewide Orientation Day which will be held in December. The next step with staffing will involve Specialist Teachers and we hope to finalise this by the end of the month.

4. OSH Care Days for 2017 – last reminder

We are starting to discuss what days we may be implementing OSH Care for 2017. At present, these days are on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 3.25pm until 6pm, but they are open to change. If you could return the form in this newsletter it would be greatly appreciated so that adequate planning can take place for next year. You can contact the office directly if you wish.

5. Swimming Program

Our Swimming Program is scheduled to be held from Monday 17th October until Friday 21st October (week 3 – term 4). This program is not included in school fees and it is an optional program, if children wish to participate. Generally, this program is of great value considering what it would cost for 5 hours of swimming lessons normally – last year the vast majority of children participated in the program which was great to see. This year, we will be swimming for 5 days straight and all students will participate in an hour program daily. All students will swim from 11.15am until 12.15pm each day. Each day we will leave school at 10.30am and return at approximately 1pm. The cost for the program is \$60 per student, which covers bus costs, swimming instructors and entry to Aquamoves in Shepparton. This is only a small increase from last year's program. This money will need to be paid as soon as possible – permission forms have gone home already and are NOW DUE.

Students not participating in the Swimming Program will be monitored at school by a teacher on duty.

6. School Policies Endorsed

We welcome any feedback on the following policies which will be endorsed at School Council in late October. These are for Registers, Working Bees and an updated version of the Parent Payment Policy. All of these are on Tiqbiz.

7. Lunch Orders

We had a smooth day last Thursday with lunch orders. A big thank you to all of the families for being so organised with this. Obviously, this makes our job a lot easier when we have to pick up the orders and then deliver these to the grades. A reminder that these are available every Thursday, with lunch orders due at school on Wednesday by 3.30pm. Lunch order pricelists have been sent home and are on Tigbiz.

8. Sharing of food

A reminder that we need up to a weeks' notice with any food shared in schools so that families can make alternative arrangements if needed for food.

9. DVD's - School Production

Could payments for these DVD's be made now please so that we can finalise the amount of copies needed for families. We have received some late orders for these so this may delay these returning to the school. Sorry for any inconvenience in regard to this.

10. Orientation Program

Information is provided in this edition of the newsletter regarding our Orientation Program for new Foundation students for 2017. Could all relevant families please put these dates into your calendar (the 3rd date has changed) – it is important that children attend the majority of these sessions so that they can begin schooling in a positive way. 13. Accident Insurance

Our school does not have an accident insurance policy to cover student injuries or ambulance transport. We recommend all families arrange ambulance cover in case of emergency. There are also a variety of commercial insurance policies available that would cover accidents at school.
