- 2. Grade Structures We hope to announce classroom teachers to the school community next week. - 3. Camp Refunds As stated previously, all camps planned for 2020 will not be going ahead because of the uncertainty in line with COVID-19. Families may request a full refund now or rollover any deposits made to next year. Please contact Karen at the office in regard to this.
- 4. School Photos We have received updated Operational Guidelines and school photos can now go ahead. There will be some modifications to the normal photo day we are only doing individual photos but still creating class groups and whole school photos based on the portraits taken. This day is now scheduled for Thursday 5th November. Online orders are preferred by the photographer.
- 5. Halloween Day This dress up day is on Friday 30th October and is not compulsory for students. If not participating normal uniform please.
- <u>6. Parent Opinion Survey</u> All parents are invited to participate in this year's survey information was sent home a couple of weeks ago via email. If you did not receive this email please let the school know and this will be followed up. All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year, the Parent Opinion Survey will be conducted from **Monday 12th October** to **Friday 13th November**.
- 7. Building Works Unfortunately, this work will go on for a few more weeks. Indoor play will be moved into the Project Space each day and some specialists will be moved into classrooms because of equipment stored in the Multipurpose Room.
- 8. COVID-19 Normal COVID-19 processes will continue at school for the time being. These include:

- * 8.45am arrivals to continue at this point this assists with extensive morning cleaning.
- * Family drop off arrangements to continue at this point. Collection points are: A-L: front car park, M-Z: back of the school gate.
- * No sharing of food between students and staff no birthday treats, pie warmers or icy poles.
- 9. Orientation Program (new Foundation students) Our Orientation Program for new Foundation students continues tomorrow as scheduled. At this stage, most sessions will begin at 9am and conclude at 11am children will need a drink and some food for our fruit snack at 10am. All children will leave the school at 11am and either be picked up by families or taken to the Kinder across the road. Children should arrive straight to school on these mornings rather than going into the Kinder first.
- 10. OSH Care Toni Marie will be leaving our OSH Care service at the end of the year. As a result, we have advertised to fill this position and if any members of the school community know of anyone who may be interested please ask them to contact the school ASAP. All families have received an expression of interest for 2021 please return this by Friday.
- 11. Policies At School Council, we updated a number of policies Working Bees, Registers, Maths & Petty Cash. We have also introduced some Standing Orders for School Council all should be on our school website by the end of the week.
- 12. Hats In line with our Sun Smart program, hats are now mandated. All students and staff will now need their school hat.
