- 1. OSH Care (Friday) School Council is currently considering not having OSH Care on a Friday because of limited places being utilised on the day. As always, we are striving to make this service financially viable for the school and we hope that it will continue to be supported for 2020. If you would like a casual or permanent position for Friday's please contact the school ASAP. A reminder about OSH Care enrolment forms which must be filled in for families to use the service this is mandated.
- 2. BYOD Program Information was handed out this week to Grade 4/5 students for 2020 and information was in last week's full edition the newsletter. Please make an appointment with Miss Lothian if you would like to discuss this program more before the end of term. An information session will be held early in 2020.
- 3. School Reports These will be handed out in sealed envelopes on Monday 16th December along with Individual Learning Plans which highlight progress.
- 4. Funfields Day Thanks to the staff and families who attended the end of year excursion day last Friday and assisted with supervision. Unfortunately, we didn't get an overly great day in regard to the weather, but it still sounds like everyone had a great time.
- 5. Policies Updated There were a number of policies reviewed and endorsed at School Council last week. These are all accessible to our families on our school website.
- 6. Traffic Update (School Crossing) There will be some work completed in regard to our school crossing hopefully before the end of the school year. This is a follow up from the meeting that was held a couple of weeks ago and more information will be in next week's full edition of the newsletter.
- 7. Muck Up Day On Thursday 19th December, the Grade 5/6 students will be having a Muck Up Day in the afternoon. This will involve some water fights and students can bring in water balloons, buckets, water pistols, etc for this. This will begin after lunch at 2pm and conclude at 2.45pm more information was in last week's newsletter.
- 8. Shirt Signing Only Grade 6 students will have an opportunity to sign some of their school shirts if they have written permission by their parents. This will need to be handed to Miss Lothian. This will occur on the last day of school in the morning and all shirts to be signed should be placed in a plastic bag. - 9. - 15. OSH Care fees. Next year, there will be a slight increase in OSH Care costs these will be \$25 for a full session and \$15 for a session up to 4.30pm. These costs were approved at School Council a couple of weeks ago.
- 16. Christmas Concert This will be held on Monday 16th December. All families received a formal letter about this evening a few weeks ago and it went on Flexibuzz also please RSVP today to assist with catering. We currently don't have the prices that Tally Lions will charge for the BBQ and drinks on the night so please be prepared with change if you wish to partake of this. Please make sure you also open the special envelope and address the information inside as soon as possible.
- 17. <u>Graduation Night</u> Plans are in place for the Grade 6 Graduation Dinner. We will have this event at school in the Multipurpose Room on Tuesday 17th December and the dinner will involve Grade 6 students and current and long standing staff at Tallygaroopna PS. The tea will be provided by the Parents' Club and begin at 6pm (lasagne, salad and chips) and we hope that some of the Grade 5 students will be able to come to the evening and act as waiters (white shirt and black pants required). More specific information will be delivered to families during the Christmas holiday period as we have done previously.
