

- 3. - 5. School Council** - The AGM will be held on Wednesday 16th March beginning at 7.30pm. This will be followed by our normal School Council meeting at 8pm. The Finance Committee will meet as per normal at 6.45pm on this night.
- 6. Random Acts of Kindness** - Congratulations to both Zane and Lachlan who organised kind gestures for 2 other students last week. Students selected at random this week to perform the random act of kindness are Lilly and Nate.
- 7. Sport Trials** - Any students in Grades 4/5/6 who are interested in the Goulburn Murray Division trials for football / netball / soccer or basketball will need to see me ASAP. Registrations are due early next week.
- 8. Puberty Sessions** - The final session will be held this Wednesday from 9.30am until 11am. Boys and girls will be separated during these sessions (myself and Miss Triffett supervising) and if you have any queries or would prefer for your child to not be involved - contact me at school please.
- 9. Cluster Aquamoves / Koorie Day** - This is a whole day excursion which is planned for this Friday. Permission forms are now due and the cost for the day is \$10 per student - includes bus, entry to Aquamoves and the Koorie program. We will leave school by bus at 9.15am at the latest and assemble at the Shepparton Lake Park at 9:30pm for an introduction to the day and provide further information to students and teachers as to how the day will unfold. The day will finish up at around 2:00 -2:30pm. All students are encouraged to apply sun cream before coming to school - this will be reapplied throughout the day.
- 10. Athletic Sports** - This is scheduled for Friday 18th March at the McEwen Reserve in Shepparton all day. Families will need to drive their children to the venue on this day. The back-up day is on Monday 21st March. Permission forms will go home this week in regard to this.
- 11. Consent Form (Headlice)** - These were sent home a couple of weeks ago and need to be returned ASAP. Headlice is a common issue that occurs at most schools and your support in regard to this would be appreciated.
- 12. School Fees** - We have had a wonderful response to this so far and this is attributed to the transparency with the Parent Payment letter that was sent home at the beginning of the year. **A reminder that fees are now due unless alternate arrangements have been made with the school office.**
- 13. Sporting Schools Program** - This program continues this week with Athletics today and Lawn Bowls on Tuesday. A reminder to pick children up promptly - 4.35pm on Monday at school and 4.45pm on Tuesday at the Recreation Reserve. There will be no Athletics next Monday because of the Labour Day long weekend.
