Outside School Hours Care



Outside School Hours Care (OSH Care)

Our school's Outside School Hours Care service is available for all families of students attending Tallygaroopna Primary School.

Our OSH Care Coordinator, Toni Marie Arnold, runs the service five days a week until 6pm (excluding school holidays and pupil free days). The service operates in the Multipurpose Room and outside as weather permits. The children are supplied with a nutritious afternoon snack at 3.30pm.

Activities are planned in consultation with the children that attend the service and may include: cooking, arts and crafts, games, music, construction, technology etc. A monthly program is displayed in the Multipurpose Room.



Fees

- Sessions cost \$25 per child or
- \$15 per child if they are picked up by 4.30pm.

All children must be picked up by 6pm or a late fee of \$5 for every 10 minutes will need to be paid. Sessions can be paid for on a pay as you go basis, or they are billed out at the end of each month. *The Child Care Subsidy is available for eligible families.*

Enrolments

To utilise this service, an enrolment form for each child needs to be completed annually. **It is recommended to complete an enrolment form in case you are unable to pick up your child/children from school at 3.25pm.**

Bookings & Cancellations

Families can indicate on the enrolment form if they wish to use the service on a permanent or casual basis. For casual bookings, families are required to call the school before 1pm. Cancellations need to be made before midday or normal fees will still apply.
